APPLICATION PROCESS

The Hillcrest High School Trust offers fully funded or partial scholarships to worthy students each year to attend Hillcrest High School. Students are selected on the basis of academic, sport, cultural or leadership merit as well as financial need. The scholarship fund is administered by the Hillcrest High School Trust Committee and worthy students chosen after a fair and rigorous selection process.

STEP 1

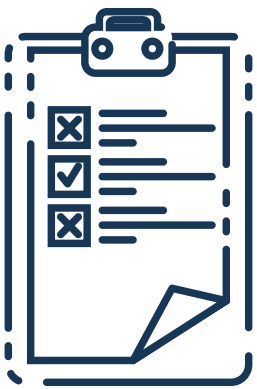


Nomination

Candidates are eligible for application through nomination only. Nominations may be from a principal or teacher, school governing body or trust member, or a member of the community who has identified a promising candidates. The nominator may not be a family member.

STEP 2



Application

Nominated students are shortlisted and will be sent an application form and link to reply for the scholarship. Applications include an application form, school report, CV, reference letter, ID and evidence of financial need.

STEP 3



Interview

Shortlisted applicants will be invited for an interview. Interviews aim to find out more about the student, who they are, what their achievements are and why they are deserving of the scholarship.

STEP 4



Notification of Success

Successful candidates will be informed of their awardance of the scholarship and will join an incredible cohort of Hillcrest Trust Scholar. Further actions will be communicated to the successful scholars.
