# OUR FUNDRAISING GOALS

We aim to award a minimum of 2 Scholarships per annum with each scholarship being reawarded annually provided the scholar meets the conditions of the scholarship. The below is an outline of the capital funds needed to continue the scholarship in perpetuum.

Schooling fees per scholar:

Per annum:

R43 000 (\$2900)

For 5 years of schooling:

R215 000 (\$14 350)

Funding needs for ten scholars in the programme per year:

R430 000 (\$28 670)

Endowment Goal:

R10 000 000 (\$670 000)
